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INTRODUCTION

General Software Installation Notes

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- Setting up WEBGLIDER with your software: Choose "WEBGLIDER" from the modem list (if a list is provided) or choose a standard/generic modem type ("standard autobaud" or "Hayes-compatible") and set your baud rate to 115,200bps.
- When using the Microsoft Windows 95 Dialer with the WEBGLIDER for PPP Internet connection, add &C1&D2&Q3 to EXTRA SETTINGS in the Advanced Connection Settings.

Registering with



You have two options for registering:

1. By calling PSINet. Then follow instructions for either:

Windows 95 (page 6) or Windows 3.x (page 15)

2. By analog (non-ISDN) modem (page 22).

IF YOU HAVE AN EXISTING ACCOUNT (and do not plan to use the supplied software, do the following):

- 1. Install the WEBGLIDER as described in the *WEBGLIDER Quick Tour Installation Guide*. Choose "WEBGLIDER" for the Dial-up Network Connection icon (**Windows 95**), and in your Internet software setup. Or, choose "Standard V.34 28800bps modem" in the Internet software setup if the WEBGLIDER is not listed.
- Add &Q3 &C1 &D2 to your initialization string to enable PPP. Or, &Q0 &C1 &D2 to enable V.120. PSINet's ISDN server uses PPP, while CompuServe's ISDN server uses V.120.

WINDOWS 95 Users - Registering with PSINet by Phone

- 1. Call **1-800-827-7482** (in the U.S.) to sign up for a new Internet account.
- 2. You will be prompted for information including, but not limited to, the following:
- current credit card account information
- connect type: **PPP**
- PC or Mac: PC
- operating system: Windows 95
- 3. Your account will be set up by PSINet and you will be given signon information. This will include your user name and password. Depending on service loads, you may be called back with your account number.

- Insert diskette 1 of 2 for CompuServe setup into your floppy drive (A: or B:). Run Setup from Program Manager (Windows 3.1) or Run from the Startup menu (Windows 95) Screens for Windows 95 and Windows 3.1 may vary slightly.
- 2. You are presented with an introductory screen including software licensing terms and other information. Select **Next** when ready.
- 3. You will be asked if you already have a Winsock installed. For Internet access, a Winsock installation is required. For Internet access through CompuServe, select **Install Winsock**, then select **Next**.
- 4. WinCIM will be installed into the destination directory automatically. To change the directory, select



Browse. If you are already a CompuServe member, uncheck the **Install Signup** box. Select **Next** to continue. Files are then copied to the specified directory on your hard drive.

- Next, you are prompted for the second installation diskette. A Program Group and icons are generated. First-time members will be prompted to sign up. Select Yes.
- 6. After reading the signup information, select **Proceed**, then:
- a. ISDN SIGNON: select Connect Settings, then set Baud Rate to 57600bps. Then set Connector to the COM port to which the WEBGLIDER is attached. Change the Access Number to 1-800-473-6282. Select Modem, then select WEBGLIDER (if available) or Hayes-compatible from Modem List. Set the Initialize field to AT &Q0 &C1 &D2 ^M. Select OK twice, then select Sign Me Up and continue with step 7. NOTE: Select Use Current (1-800-473-6282) Access Number when prompted.
- b. ANALOG SIGNON: select Sign Me Up to continue, or select other options for more information.
- 7. You are then asked for: Agreement Number, Resident Country, Payment method, Account Usage, and Serial Number. The agreement number and serial number can be found on the WinCIM envelope. Select **Proceed** when ready.
- 8. Next, you are asked for various personal data. Continue selecting **Proceed**. You are then presented with service agreement terms. When you are satisfied, proceed.

9. Specify Phone Dial Type, then select Proceed. Then specify the communications port, then OK. Now. select Sign Me Up and Baud Rate. Finally, select Sign **Up** to connect to CompuServe through your modem.

At the end of the signup process, you will receive a confirmation screen with an account number and password. CompuServe installation is now complete. A few **CompuServe ISDN access** numbers are as follows:

WINDOWS 95: Select START, then RUN and type A:SETUP (or B:SETUP).

WINDOWS 3.X: Select FILE, then RUN and type A:SETUP (or B:SETUP).

NOTE: If ProShare is provided on CD-ROM, the path will change from A:SETUP (B:SETUP) to D:\PROSHARE\DISK1\SETUP.

After files are copied, start ProShare. Click **CONFERENCE**, then **SETUP**.

- 5. Check the **CUSTOMIZE MODEM STRINGS** box, then set **INITIALIZE**: to **AT &Q0 &C1 &D2**. Click **OK** twice to finish.
